Doors open for exhibitors at 8:30 a.m. Friday and 9:30 a.m. Saturday. This is a two-day show. Exhibitors must be ready at 9:30 a.m. and remain open during all show hours and until 5:00 p.m. Saturday. Check-In at EOWA table for booth assignment and packet. Tables will be in place Thursday. Building is locked overnight. Tables must be covered on top and all 4 sides to the floor (sheets not permitted).

APPLICATIONS

This is a woodcarving and folk art festival. All exhibited items must be hand-crafted by the exhibitor. Registrations should be received no later than May 26, 2019. Late registration will be accepted based on cancellations. Exhibitors must sign Agreement on Application Form. Exhibitors under 18 years of age must have an adult (21 years or older) sponsor in the booth.

First-time Show applicants are required to submit pictures representative of their work with their application. The Show Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any application and/or display and is the final authority on all show policies.

SEMINARS AND DEMONSTRATIONS


