

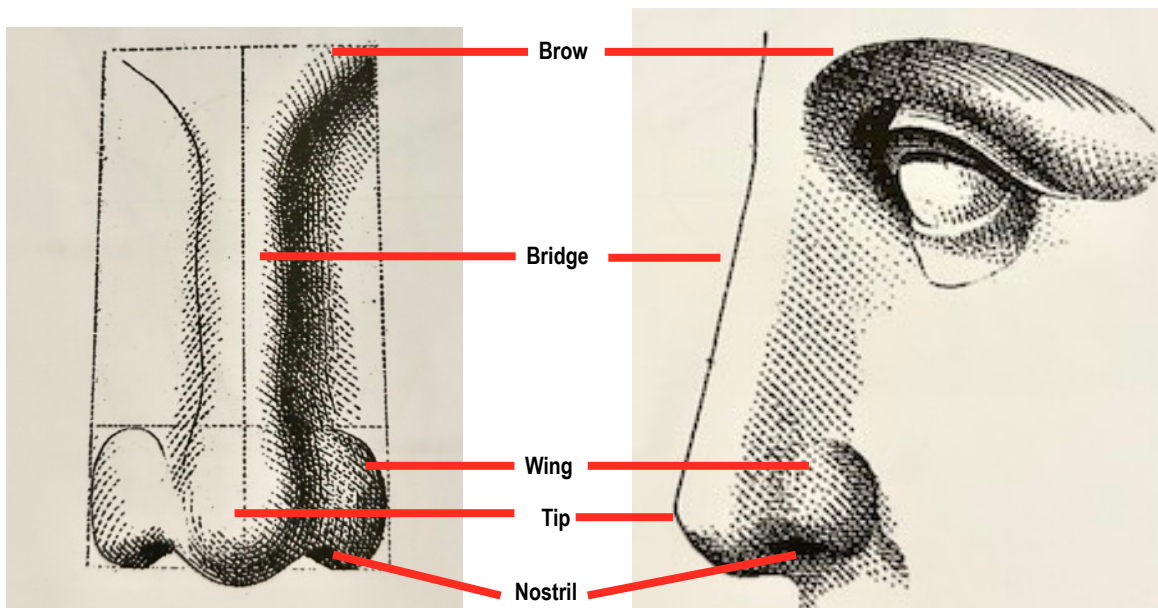


**NEXT MEETING: Wednesday, April 9,

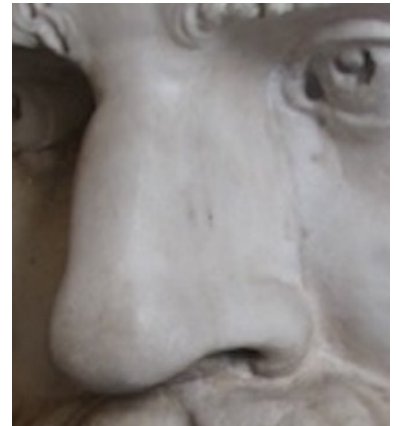

Steps for carving the nose:
Make notches 1 and 2 to define brow and tip. Rough out bridge 3 (upper left). Define width of nose on both sides 4. Rough in nostril 5 (above center). Fix eye position for depth of nose 6. Further define wing 7 and 8 (above right). Complete wing 9 and make nostril the last thing done 10 (left). Finished nose (right).
